When should you keep your child home from school?

- Fever greater than 100 F
 - Vomiting
 - Diarrhea
 - Uncontrolled productive cough
 - Open, oozing rash/wound
 - Pink eye
 - Green/yellow nasal mucous discharge
 - Any condition preventing your child from participating comfortably in usual daily activities
- Make sure to label your child's sweatshirts, jackets, hats, etc.*
